PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

EVERBUILD® FLOOR PAINT is a solvent-based polyurethane floor paint designed to provide a clean hard wearing finish to concrete, stone and wooden floors subject to light to medium traffic. Ideal for use on garage floors, workshops, storerooms, walkways etc. EVERBUILD® FLOOR PAINT gives enhanced durability, abrasion resistance and a good resistance to dilute acids/alkalis and oils.

APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

SUBSTRATE QUALITY / PRE-TREATMENT

All surfaces must be clean, dry (to touch) and free from grease and other contaminants. Remove all loose and flaking material with a scraper and a stiff brush back to a sound surface. Remove all organic growth with EVERBUILD PATIO WIZARD. Chemically or mechanically hardened floor may need abrasion prior to use. If in doubt test a small area prior to full application.

APPLICATION

Concrete must be a minimum of 6 months old before paint can be applied. Priming is not normally required, however the first coat on concrete or porous surfaces should first be thinned with up to 10% white spirit and

Product Data Sheet EVERBUILD® FLOOR PAINT June 2019, Version 01.01 020813020010000016 allowed to dry. EVERBUILD® FLOOR PAINT is touch dry in 2-4 hours depending on ambient temperatures. NOTE low temperatures can significantly extend drying time. Apply using a brush or roller to give an even coating. 2 coats are normally required allowing 16-24 hours between coats.

CLEANING OF TOOLS

Clean tools and brushes with white spirits/turps subs immediately after use. Cured product can only be removed mechanically.

LIMITATIONS

- Do not use on concrete floors with a moisture level of above 18%, which do not have a waterproof membrane or concrete floors containing a dust suppressing additive.
- New concrete must be a minimum of 6 months old before painting.
- Suitable for light to medium traffic only, for areas subject to heavy traffic or constant use, an epoxybased product is recommended.
- Do not use on bitumen or asphalt.
- Mechanically or chemically hardened floors may need abrasion prior to application.
- As the company cannot be aware of all applications and materials the product can be used on, it is the users responsibility to determine suitability for use. If in doubt contact technical services for advice.
