- Cleaner to prepare seams of Sikaplan® PVC waterproofing membranes for hot air welding application

APPLICATION

Soak a white cotton cloth with the cleaner and remove contamination from seam overlap surfaces. Do not apply cleaner directly onto the membrane surface. For difficult residue removal, a Scotch Brite pad can also be used. Dry the surface of the membrane overlap with a white cotton cloth. To remove mineral contamination from the membrane surface the SikaRoof® Cleaner 2000 may be diluted with water.
