With the tower set to reopen having been adapted for both visitors and for weddings, receptions and

corporate events, the operations agent Cofely GDF Suez required a high performing flooring system that would withstand heavy foot traffic.

In 2012, working with main contractor Sir Robert McAlpine, Lucas Fit Out was appointed to install approximately 1,800m² of hard wearing and slip resistant flooring surfaces throughout this unusual structure. To achieve this, the company specified a wide range of market proven flooring products from Sika.

Developed to offer an outstanding surface finish and exceptional protection against loading, abrasion and chemical exposure – the Sikafloor[®] system proved ideal for the heavy footfall of this visitor attraction. The specification comprised of a primer of Sikafloor[®]-261 followed by a Sikafloor[®]-263 SL in grey broadcast with anti-slip quartz aggregate. A layer of Sikafloor 330 was then applied to regulate and level the surface before a sealer layer of Sikafloor[®]-305W, completing the total system thickness of just 2mm.

Following the change of use and a reconfiguration of the two observation decks in preparation for the spring 2014 opening, Crown Flooring was appointed to reseal the flooring with a layer of Sikafloor[®]-305W.

Extremely tough and durable and with a life expectancy to match, Sika's flooring systems are designed to fulfil an almost endless combination of functional and aesthetic requirements and meet all industry requirements for mechanical and chemical resistance, impermeability and fire resistance.

As an alternative to traditional finishes, Sika flooring systems can serve any number of specifier demands on a wide range of projects.
